Commitment to Achieving Net Zero

North West Social Care and Support Ltd is committed to achieving net zero carbon emissions across its UK operations by **2050**, in line with UK Government targets.

We recognise the impact our services have on the environment and are committed to taking proportionate and meaningful steps to reduce our carbon footprint as part of our ongoing organisational development.

Additional Details Relating to Baseline

North West Social Care and Support Ltd has not previously formally measured or reported its carbon emissions. Therefore, this Carbon Reduction Plan establishes our first baseline assessment, based on reasonable estimates aligned to our operational model.

Our emissions are primarily generated through:

- Energy use within supported accommodation properties
- Staff travel between sites and for service delivery
- Procurement of goods and services

These are considered low to moderate in comparison to higher-impact sectors, but we recognise the importance of monitoring and reducing emissions over time.

Emissions Reduction Targets

In order to achieve net zero by 2050, North West Social Care and Support Ltd has set the following initial targets:

- Reduce overall emissions by **20% by 2030**
- Continue staged reductions to achieve **net zero by 2050**

We will review and strengthen these targets annually as our data improves and monitoring systems develop.

Carbon Reduction Projects

Completed / Ongoing Measures

The organisation has already implemented a number of environmental measures which contribute to carbon reduction:

- Use of **localised service delivery models**, reducing travel distances
- Adoption of **further digital systems and reduced paper usage**
- Encouragement of **efficient staff travel planning and car sharing where appropriate**
- Use of **energy-efficient appliances and lighting** within supported accommodation
- Property investment to improve building standards and efficiency
- Minimising waste and promoting recycling within services

These measures will continue to be applied when delivering services under this contract.



Future Carbon Reduction Initiatives

We are committed to further reducing emissions through the following actions:

- Monitoring and reducing **staff travel and mileage**
- Improving energy efficiency across properties (e.g. insulation, heating controls)
- Encouraging use of **public transport and low-emission vehicles**
- Reviewing supplier practices to prioritise environmentally responsible providers
- Increasing staff awareness of sustainability through training
- Exploring potential transition to **low-carbon or electric vehicles** where feasible

These initiatives will be reviewed regularly and incorporated into business planning.

Declaration and Sign-Off

This Carbon Reduction Plan has been completed in accordance with **Procurement Policy Note (PPN) 006** and associated guidance and reporting standards.

Emissions have been reported and recorded in line with the **GHG Reporting Protocol corporate standard** and use appropriate UK Government conversion factors where applicable.
